#### Notes:

- All students aged 9+ who are new to Virginia Ballet Company and School must take a free trial placement assessment. After the assessment, students will be placed into a level based on knowledge and ability. Students aged 8 and younger are placed into levels based on age. Please email or call to schedule a placement assessment.
- Intermediate IV level dancers are eligible to participate in the fall contemporary performance, VBC's annual production of Nutcracker, and the spring performance. They may join the Touring Ensemble in order to be considered to perform at community engagement events. Separate performance fees are required to participate in productions with additional days/times for rehearsals.
- It is <u>recommended</u> that dancers invest in eight classes/week: three ballet classes, two pointe classes, one modern class, and two variations classes, unless informed otherwise by the Artistic Staff. If the dancer is invited to join the pas de deux class, the recommended weekly class load is nine classes per week. These are the minimum requirements to improve in knowledge and body strength **and to be considered for solos in VBC's classical ballet productions**.
- Intermediate IV students who wish to perform in VBC productions <u>must</u> be enrolled in six classes per week, including <u>at least</u> two ballet classes, two pointe classes, one variation class, and one modern class. These are the minimum requirements to continue to improve in knowledge, technique, and musicality. Intermediate IV students not enrolled in eight or nine classes per week, as denoted in the previous paragraph, <u>will not</u> be considered for solos in classical ballet performances.
- For students to be on pointe they must be registered and attend a minimum of two ballet classes and two pointe classes per week.
- Students will be evaluated after Fall Semester and undergo an end-of-the-year examination during the Spring Semester to determine readiness to progress to the next level. Promotion is not guaranteed. To progress, dancers must demonstrate the knowledge, strength, focus, and skill required to be successful at a higher level and to protect themselves from potential injury.
- Maximum Tuition and Unlimited Classes: The maximum number of hours that Intermediate IV level students may enroll for Spring 2025 is 22 hours. Tuition is capped at the rate of \$2,810/semester for students enrolled in at least 14 hours of classes/week. Students may take the additional eight hours of classes/week at no extra charge.

- 10 % Early Bird Discount **if tuition is paid in full by January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025.** May not be combined with any discounts except 5% sibling discount.
- 10% active duty military discount with current military ID may be combined with 5% sibling discount.
- New student discount of 30% off one full semester class if enrolled by February 28, 2025. This may not be combined with any other discounts <u>except</u> sibling discount (5%).
