Notes:

- All students age 9+ who are new to Virginia Ballet Company and School must take a free trial placement assessment. After the assessment, students will be placed into a level based on knowledge and ability. Students age 8 and younger are placed into levels based on age. Please email or call to schedule a placement assessment.
- Advanced level dancers are eligible to participate in the fall contemporary performance, VBC's annual production of Nutcracker, and the spring performance. They may join the Touring Ensemble in order to be considered to perform at community engagement events.
- Separate performance fees are required to participate in these productions and Touring Ensemble with additional days/times for rehearsals.
- It is **recommended** that dancers invest in nine classes/week: three ballet classes, two pointe classes, two variations class, one contemporary/modern class, and one pas de deux class, unless informed otherwise by the Artistic Staff. These are the minimum requirements to improve in knowledge and body strength **and to be considered for solos in VBC's classical ballet productions.**
- Students who wish to perform in VBC productions **must** be enrolled in six classes per week, including **at least** two ballet classes, two pointe classes, one modern class, and one variation class. These are the minimum requirements to continue to improve in knowledge, technique, and musicality. Advanced students not enrolled in nine classes per week **will not** be considered for solos in classical ballet performances.
- Recreational dancers who are not interested in performing but want to learn Classical Ballet or Modern technique are recommended to enroll in four to six classes per week to maintain their skill as an Advanced dancer.
- For students to be on pointe they must be registered and attend a minimum of two ballet classes and two pointe classes per week.
- Maximum Tuition and Unlimited Classes: The maximum number of hours that Advanced level students may enroll for Spring 2026 is 22 hours. Tuition is capped at the rate of \$2,810/semester for students enrolled in at least 14 hours of classes/week. Students may take the additional eight hours of classes/week at no extra charge.
