Notes:

- All students aged 9+ who are new to Virginia Ballet Company and School must take a free trial placement assessment. After the assessment, students will be placed into a level based on knowledge and ability. Students aged 8 and younger are placed into levels based on age. Please email or call to schedule a placement assessment.
- Intermediate I dancers are eligible to participate in the fall contemporary performance, VBC's annual production of Nutcracker, and the spring performance. Separate performance fees are required to participate in productions with additional days/times for rehearsals.
- Students who wish to perform in VBC productions **must** be enrolled in four classes per week: two ballet classes and two modern classes (jazz may be taken to fulfill this requirement). These are the minimum requirements to continue to improve in knowledge, technique, and musicality. Any student who wishes to be considered to perform Trepak in VBC's Nutcracker must also take character class. However, please note that enrollment in character class does not guarantee that a dancer will be cast in Trepak.
- Students will be evaluated after Fall Semester and undergo an end-of-the-year examination during the Spring Semester to determine readiness to progress to the next level. Promotion is not guaranteed. To progress, dancers must demonstrate the knowledge, strength, focus, and skill required to be successful at a higher level and to protect themselves from potential injury.
